










# FY 2020-21 Budget Planning Setting The Public Hearing





- Normally July Meeting

- Two Options
  - July Meeting Moved One Week Later 7/15/20
  - Budget Hearing August
- Notice To County Due Now
- Board Approves Resolution
  - Adopt Proposed Budget
  - Set The Hearing Date
